A Jaeger-LeCoultre gilt brass circular cased desk timepiece with eight day movement, the signed dial with gilt baton hour markers and date aperture, diameter 9.7cm, a Jaeger desk alarm clock and barometer, the signed cream dial centred with a mercury thermometer, within a red and gilt case, length 10.7cm, and a Smiths alarm clock, the signed square dial supported by a chrome plated stirrup frame, height 13.5cm.

Condition Report

1179. Jaeger desk timepiece - generally good condition, typical light wear to gilt case and a bit dusty/dirty around edge of glass. Dial is clean with only a few dirt specks visible under magnification. It is currently in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Red and gilt Jaeger desk alarm clock/barometer - typical wear to gilt on case, particularly the back door. Otherwise dial is good and clean. Not working at present.

Smiths horseshoe clock - does not run and unable to wind. Typical light wear to case.

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
