Condition Report

345. Frame is in generally good order, but is a little tired with some wear and minor misshaping to supports, but no significant damage or repairs. Good clear hallmarks to underside, one of the silver topped glass bottles has chips to neck and few of the bottles have very minor chips to underside of bottles, otherwise glassware in good order. Silver weights 556.5g.
