A large sectional cut glass centrepiece, 19th century, designed as an hexagonal base with stylized foliate spreading foot, supporting a circular comport section with faceted detail and shaped cut turnover rim, surmounted by a separate vase shaped section, which could be used separately, unmarked, overall height 59cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1627. Fundamentally in good condition overall, there are some issues, but these do not stand out and are only really noticeable on close inspection.

Base - two chips to upper base edge of foot, approx 1cm square, and small glued chip and minor nick to upper section where centre comport rests.

Centre - three chips and some small nicks to cut rim edge.

Top - bruise and minor chip to base edge, minor chipping to top rim edge.
