LOT 4001

A Victorian Gothic Revival oak dresser by Holland & Sons, possibly designed by Bruce James Talbert, the carved and stained pediment above three open shelves flanked by chamfered corners, the raised side supports with pierced trefoil tracery, inlaid banding and incised foliate decoration, the frieze fitted with a single drawer, stamped 'Holland & Sons', height 196cm, width 96cm, depth 44cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

4001. General surface condition is good and there are no later additions or alterations. The main condition issue is the front projections having splayed outwards slightly, which has left a gap in the carcass at the sides of the drawer section. There is a small section of slight gapping in the wood on the right-side top. Overall scuffs, marks and surface wear, also some wear to the lower corners of the upright supports. The surface above the drawer has some light water marks and wear to the polish. The drawer runs smoothly, but as stated this needs some attention.
