Condition Report

2143. The covering is definitely later, but has been done well using a good quality blue velvet. It is buttoned and is sprung underneath. All in good condition. Structurally the stool is very sound. The surface of the legs are a bit scuffed and scratched with some areas of slight retouching and repainting to the turnings and fluting. Some slight wear to the castors.
