A near pair of early 20th century Norwegian silver gilt and plique-à-jour spoons, each bowl decorated with polychrome flowerheads, the terminal similarly decorated on a spiral twist handle, unmarked, length 16.5cm.

Condition Report

449. Spoon 1 - generally good order with some minor faults. The bowl is in good order with no losses or repairs. There are some typical hairlines to the blue ground. The finial has one green petal of enamel missing, but wire surround is intact, other green petals all intact and in good order. Petals to yellow/gold flowers are all intact and in good order. Typical minor hairlines only visible under magnification.

Spoon 2 - all in good condition with no significant damage or losses. Typical minor hairlines visible under magnification.
