### LOT 447

A pair of early 20th century Norwegian silver gilt and plique-à-jour spoons, each bowl decorated with blue and green flowerheads, the terminal similarly decorated on a spiral twist handle, unmarked, length 15cm.

### Condition Report

447. Spoon 1 - generally good condition. Bowl in good order with no losses, typical minor hairlines to clear opaque ground only visible under x10 magnification. Finial in good order with no significant damage or losses, few typical minor hairlines visible under magnification.

Spoon 2 - bowl in good order with no losses, but typical minor hairlines to opaque ground which is visible under magnification. Green flower to finial is missing half of its green leaf. Two outer petals of the blue flowers are broken and missing. The two silver outer wire frames and one piece of blue enamel is present, but detached. A professional repair is required to return this section to good condition.
