A Chinese crackle glazed porcelain bowl, late Qing dynasty, of steep-sided circular form, the exterior painted with a pair of iron red dragons and flaming pearls above green waves, the interior with red dragon roundel, underglaze blue artemisia leaf and double ring to base, height 7cm, diameter 13cm.

Condition Report

1046. It appears to be in good condition with no significant damage and no repairs. The decoration is good and vibrant. Owing to the crackle glaze it is difficult to see any hairlines and there is nothing obvious other than the crackle lines, however when you give it a tap it sounds a little dead, so it is possible one of the crackle lines has developed into a hairline, or it could just be that the crackle glaze makes it sound a bit dead.
