A Japanese carved ivory okimono figure of a fisherman, Meiji period, modelled standing on a rocky outcrop with anchor resting on his shoulder, inset red lacquer signature plaque with incised two-character signature to base, height 17cm.

Condition Report

1144. Overall good condition with no significant damage or repairs. One of the points of the anchor has been chipped and there is a crack to the rope just where it meets the rock, which has had a super glue repair to stabilize it but this is not immediately noticeable. Minor natural shrinkage hairline across the back of his head.
