A pair of late 18th/early 19th century silkwork studies of a bird perched on the branches of a leafy bush, worked in coloured silks on an ivory-toned silk ground, 18cm x 16cm, within period ebonized frames.

Condition Report

2805. The frames appear to be very near period or original. Both silkworks have some light browning to the silk ground and some slight typical fading of colour. One has some blue colour run below the dark embroidered ground section. Both are slightly crinkled but don't seem to have perished anywhere. Overall bumps, scratches and scuffs to frames.

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
