An early Victorian needlework sampler 'Worked by the Girls in the Pimlico British School, April 20th 1842', finely worked with a central reserve enclosing a pair of children, within borders of rose sprays, 47cm x 46.5cm, within a Hogarth section frame.

Condition Report

2803. An overall slight browning to canvas and minor fading of colour. As the canvas round is quite thin there are quite a few areas of small holes scattered throughout, including a more substantial tear to the left corner of the figures. There is also some substantial corrosion to the threads around the borders, in particular the reds. It appears to have been laid down and taped with a leather edging around the borders.

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
