A group of Victorian miniature needlework items, comprising three pairs of gloves, a bonnet, two pairs of socks and three small samplers, one detailed 'I hope Brighter hours may come Dear Mother', probably all worked by one child, mounted within a bird's eye maple frame, 49cm x 40cm.

Condition Report

2831. The frame is Victorian and generally in good order with a few small chips to the edges of the veneer. It appears to have been re-laid onto green backboard in 2011, the reverse having a dated conservation label attached. The items themselves have not been inspected out of the frame, so can only see one side but the general appearance and condition appears good. The top left pair of gloves have some areas of slight surface deterioration and the small central panel has some fraying to its edges. Otherwise just some minor browning and a few ageing spots.
