Condition Report

2470. The exterior is lightly worn with some light scuffs to the edges and corners. The right hand has a slightly more scuffed patch to the bottom edge. The lock is a tiny bit loose but does work ok. Both inkwells appear to be original and have some minor scuffs and scratches, one lid with a very slight tear to edge. The pen appears to be ok but the seal is probably a replacement.
