### LOT 1527

A Royal Copenhagen porcelain figure of a Goose Girl, circa 1962, model No. 528, height 18cm, together with a Copenhagen porcelain model of a seal and another of a kingfisher, two Bing & Grondahl figure groups and a Copenhagen porcelain figure of a lady in 18th century dress, raised on a pseudo marble base, early 20th century, Juliane Marie Crown mark to base, height 20.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

1527. Lady in 18th century dress - miniscule nick to back base edge corner of base. Losses to very fine edges of lacework around edges of collar and sleeves. Tiny chip to tail end of one ribbon on brim of hat. No restoration.

Goose Girl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Boy Kissing Girl - good condition, minor glazed over manufacturer's nick to base edge.

Girl with Dog - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Kingfisher - tiny chip to tip of beak, otherwise ok.

Seal - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
