A late 18th century gold mourning ring of glazed navette shaped form with a view of a gentleman standing beside a classical urn below a willow tree within a bright cut engraved border, the back engraved 'Joseph Else Obt 9 March 1780 Aet 49', ring size approx K1/2, length 3.2cm.

501. The interior of the locket compartment has slight foxing. Two interior sections of gold band are loose within the ring and some seed pearls are also loose within the ring. The ring may have been restored in the past. The piece otherwise is in fairly good condition. Weight 6.7g.
