LOT 540

A late 19th century gold backed and silver set diamond brooch, probably French, designed as a floral spray, mounted with two principal cushion shaped diamonds and smaller cushion shaped and rose cut diamonds, the principal flowerhead mounted en tremblant, fitted with a safety chain, length 7.4cm, with a later fitted case.

Estimate: £600 - £800

Condition Report

540. The brooch is in generally good condition. The two principal diamonds slightly draw colour and have one or two internal inclusions. There is some variation of cut to the remaining diamonds and some have a few internal inclusions. Suggested age  circa 1890. Weight 20.5g.

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
