## LOT 560

A Victorian 18ct gold and diamond ring, designed as a coiled snake, the head and the eyes mounted with rose cut and cushion shaped diamonds, London 1872, ring size approx L.

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## Condition Report

560. The diamonds have some variation of cut. The diamonds are generally fairly white stones. The smallest diamond at the back of the head looks to be cracked. There is slight wear to the facet edges of some of the other diamonds. Hallmark legible. The ring otherwise is in fairly good condition. Largest diamond width 2.5mm. Cannot estimate carat weight due to setting.
