## LOT 641

A late 19th century gold backed and silver fronted diamond brooch in a curved and tapered foliate pierced design, mounted with cushion shaped diamonds with the principal diamond to the centre, length 4.5cm, with a case.

Estimate: £250 - £350

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## Condition Report

641. The principal diamond looks to be a fairly clear stone and of attractive white colour. Some of the remaining diamonds have one or two small inclusions but they are generally fairly clear. The claws to some diamonds look to be rather worn. The curved nature of the brooch would suggest that it once formed part of the front of a bracelet. The brooch would benefit from professional cleaning.
