A Doulton Rembrandt ware stoneware vase, late 19th/early 20th century, decorated with lighthouses and boats at sea beneath inscription 'For those in peril on the sea', impressed mark to base, height 44.2cm.

Condition Report

1480. Approximately half of the neck rim has been professionally restored with clear overspraying to the neck rim overall. There is similar professional restoration with considerable repainting to at least half of the bottom lower third of the vase. It is not possible to determine what exactly has occurred (even with a black light) but it is well executed and the main lighthouse decoration is unaffected. The glaze is typically crazed overall with some bruises to the surface around the lower half of the body.
