A pair of Royal Worcester porcelain cabinet cups and saucers, 1921 and 1922, painted by Ernest Barker, signed, with sheep in landscape settings, the cup exteriors gilt, puce printed factory marks, diameter of saucers 9.5cm (one cup cracked).

Condition Report

1512. First cup - approx 2cm long vertical haircrack almost opposite handle, otherwise ok.

Second cup - crazed but otherwise in good condition.

First saucer - in good condition.

Second saucer - faint approx 1cm long hairline to rim at 5 o'clock, otherwise ok.
