A Doulton Burslem porcelain jug, late 19th/early 20th century, the slender tapering body painted with two ducks below foliate gilt decoration, printed mark to base, height 31cm, together with two Royal Doulton porcelain vases, both decorated with sheep within a landscape, heights 22cm and 22.5cm (both with restoration).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1474. Jug - in good condition overall, two minor horizontal hairlines to vertical section of spout and some wear to gilding of handle.

Two-handled vase - finely crazed overall. One handle completely re-gilt, probably due to a break which is not detectable but the regilding is quite noticeable in comparison to the other handle.

Cylindrical vase - four small areas of professional restoration to the rim, some minor surface marks when viewed very closely.
