A Chinese Canton famille rose celadon ground porcelain vase, mid to late 19th century, painted with blue and white foliate roundels, heightened in gilt against a ground of birds, butterflies and flowers, height 23.5cm, together with a Canton famille rose cylindrical vase, height 23cm, a pair of flared cylindrical beaker vases, height 21cm, and a later plate (some faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1161. Celadon ground vase - numerous small chips around the rim and typical light wear to gilt and enamels, otherwise in ok condition.

Pair of trumpet vases - broken into four pieces and re-glued, also typical light wear to enamels and gilt. Few small chips to rim and 4cm hairline crack to rim. Otherwise typical light wear to gilt and enamels.

Cylindrical vase - 5.5cm x 0.5cm chips to rim and typical wear to gilt and enamels, otherwise good.

Plate - later in date - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
