Condition Report

1253. Generally fairly sound condition, but with typical wear, chip and losses to edges and some spotting/lifting to lacquer on the top. One hinge door has a broken top hinge. Two top scrolls to surmount are loose. One of the metal mounts to sides is missing a small section. Typical wear to gilt decoration on front. Colours are good and fresh to sides.
