A Chinese silk embroidered panel, late Qing dynasty, finely worked in coloured and gilt threads with two figures holding an incense burner and lotus stems within a surround of rocks, prunus, pine and flowers with fenghuang flying above and monkey, lingzhi fungus and deer below, 30cm x 20.5cm, framed and glazed, together with a pair of Chinese silk embroidered sleeve panels depicting figures in landscapes on a cream ground, 52.5cm x 11.3cm, framed and glazed.

Condition Report

1224. Figural panel - generally good condition with good vibrant colours. Stitching is good with a few minor spots of staining to background silk.

Pair of sleeve panels - good condition, good vibrant colours, minor spots of staining, but nothing significant.
