### Condition Report

2420. the larger box has some surface spots and an overall bloom to the surface. One side and rear panel has some surface craquelure and distressing to the surface as well as a few surface spots and slight scratching. The watch case has a slightly yellowed top with overall craquelure. The locking clip is lacking part of it so does not clip close. The interior material is quite worn and misshapen at the bottom.
