A Chinese famille rose export porcelain garniture of three vases, Qianlong period, comprising a pair of trumpet beaker vases and a baluster vase, each painted with a pheasant perched on blue rockwork amidst flowers and blossoming branches, heights 23cm, 24cm and 24cm (baluster vase with rim restoration).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1035. Trumpet vase 1 - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light wear to enamels.

Trumpet vase 2 - good condition, tiny chip to rim and typical light wear to enamels. Slight staining to glaze to underside of foot.

Baluster vase - minor restoration/overpainting to rim, otherwise good condition with no significant damage. Typical light wear to enamels.
