A Chinese famille rose export porcelain vase, Qianlong period, of baluster form, painted with a pheasant and butterflies amidst peonies and other flowers, height 35.5cm (cracked).

## **Condition Report**

1125. Large cracks running from the rim, downward and over half way down the body and then turning but up in a 'U' shape. These cracks have made the body unstable so restoration/repair is vital. More cracks across the base. Enamels are good and vibrant. Typical light surface wear.
