A Chinese blue silk embroidered jacket/short robe, late Qing dynasty, finely worked in coloured threads with an all-over design of butterflies and scattered flowers on a coral ground, the borders, cuffs and collar decorated with blue and black flowers and scrolling foliage on a cream ground, length 113cm, together with a Chinese silk embroidered waistcoat, length 38cm, a Japanese black silk kimono and a silk gown.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1233. Blue silk jacket - generally fairly good condition, but there is some wear and fraying along side joins. Pink interior is worn and frayed in places. Embroidery colours are good and vibrant with only minor unstitching. Blue silk has some slight discolouration and minor staining as well as some minor areas of wear/fraying. Cream borders in similarly worn condition.

Waistcoats - generally fair condition with some wear, some unstitching to gilt thread and slight crinkling to brown silk ground, slight fraying to blue borders. Colours are good and vibrant.

2 Japanese robes - generally good condition with typical minor wear etc.

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
