Five pieces of Zsolnay Pécs floral decorated pottery in the Persian taste, early 20th century, comprising a pierced boat shaped bowl, length 42cm, a bulbous ewer with lobed detail, height 21cm, a similar smaller ewer, height 17cm, a jug with reticulated base, height 20cm, and a small jardinière with pierced rim, height 10cm (some faults and restoration).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

1435. Boat shaped bowl - typical crazing to glaze and rubbing to gilt rim, otherwise in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Ewer with lobed detail - 2 of the 3 relief pink sections on the handle re-stuck, minor glaze grazing to tips of each of these 3 sections. Crack to upper handle terminal. Some long craze lines.

Similar smaller ewer - everted part of neck rim broken and repaired. Overall crazing to glaze.

Jug - crazed overall. Firing crack to edge of foot. Small chip to footrim.

Jardiniere - very light rubbing to gilding, but in good condition.
