Condition Report

1007. Generally good condition, typical light wear and surface scratches. Slightly misshapen rim. Some minor pitting, but no losses or repairs to enamel. Faint hairline to turquoise interior and minor stress hairlines and some surface scratching. Footrim with minor misshaping and some light wear to gilt.
