A late Victorian silver mounted cut clear glass double-ended scent bottle of faceted form, the hinged and screw-off covers of domed foliate form, London 1890 by Charles Boyton, together with two other similar double-ended glass scent bottles, one with green tinted facet cut body, length 12.5cm, the other with red tinted body, length 14cm (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

2416. The clear glass bottle has some very minor surface scratches.

The green bottle has some minor pushed-in dents to one of the lids, otherwise some minor wear.

The red glass bottle is quite worn, with wear and repairs to the screw-off ends. The hinged lid is a bit pressed in on the top and does not seem to clip down shut. Some minor nibbles to the edges and corners of the glass

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
