A Buren silver circular cased wristwatch with signed jewelled lever movement, the enamelled dial with Arabic numerals, the case back interior numbered '176276', import mark London 1915, case diameter 3.4cm, together with a Sicura Automatic steel backed gentleman's wristwatch, the signed black dial with day and date apertures and centre seconds, case diameter 3.8cm, and a Seiko Chronograph Automatic steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, the signed silvered dial with two subsidiary dials, day and date apertures and outer tachymeter scale, case diameter 4cm, on a leather strap.
