A Barr Flight & Barr Worcester porcelain inkwell, circa 1807-13, the kidney shaped body painted with a rectangular panel of a dog against an apricot gilt caillouté ground, the gilded loop handle with mask terminal, red printed factory marks to base, length 13.5cm (restored).

## Condition Report

1451. Handle broken at lower terminal and above mask and professionally restored with re-gilding, including left ear of mask. Convex well to left of handle restored and re-gilt with associated re-gilding to rim of main body and running behind handle. Three very minor chips to underside rim edge above painted panel - not visible unless inverted. Otherwise, typical very minor rubbing to gilding. Lacking liner and cover of well.
