A Zsolnay Pécs square shaped inkwell, 1880s, the body moulded with figural medieval panels below a spherical hinged lid, opening to reveal a glass inkwell, impressed marks to base, height 19.5cm.

Condition Report

1414. Overall crazing to glaze with some staining primarily visible to interior. Pottery neck of well where metal mount attached has been broken off and clearly glued back into position. The hinge of the lid is loose as it's slightly misshapen. When open the cover rest on the back of the main body and there is some minor bruising to the lid in this position. Removable glass well is present and would appear to be original. Gilding to shoulders, neck and lid rubbed.
