A Minton porcelain plate, circa 1877, painted with two seated young girls eating cherries in a farmyard scene, impressed marks to base, diameter 24cm, together with a Royal Doulton porcelain plate, 20th century, decorated with a classical maiden standing beside a plinth while filling a vase with flowers, printed marks to base, diameter 27cm.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1447. Minton plate - some typical minor crazing to turquoise rim. A few scratches to painted scene, e.g. across water trough and to skirts. Otherwise ok.

Doulton plate - crazing particularly noticeable to well. 2cm long hairline visible to underside at 7 o'clock where there are also 2 scratches to the upper surface rim edge. Some rubbing to gilt rim.
