A Victorian gold and turquoise brooch of shaped oval form, circa 1840, the centre with a forget-me-not flower spray within a scroll surround, the back glazed with a locket compartment, width 2.5cm, and a gold and turquoise brooch, designed as a wreath, detailed '750', width 3.5cm.

Condition Report

594. Flower brooch - there is some variation of colour to the turquoise of the flowerhead. The hook and security catch to the pin have been later added. There is a small dent visible to the border of the back but generally the brooch is in good condition.

Wreath brooch ♦ one stem is slightly bent. The roller action to the hook is missing, otherwise the brooch is in quite good condition.
