A gold and half-pearl set collar necklace, circa 1900, formed as a row of alternating large trefoil and small trefoil shaped motifs, the front with a detachable gold and half-pearl pendant brooch in a six pointed starburst design, with a detachable brooch pin fitting, length of necklace 41.5cm, length of pendant brooch 3cm, with a later case.

Condition Report

595. The pearls have an attractive silvery lustre. The necklace is in overall good condition. Two short lengths of gold curb chain have been added either side of the clasp in order to lengthen the necklace (1cm and 1.5cm). Weight 35.6g.

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
