An 18ct gold and diamond three stone ring, claw set with the principal cushion shaped diamond between two smaller cushion shaped diamonds, London 1985, ring size approx N, principle diamond weight approx 2.00ct, with a case.

Condition Report

605. The principal diamond looks to be an attractive white stone and fairly clear. The two side diamonds are well matched for colour, however one diamond has surface reaching fracturing to the side of the table facet. The ring is otherwise in good condition. Centre stone diamond weight approx 1.4-1.5ct. Colour: approx J-K. Clarity: approx SI1. Weight 3.8g.

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
