Condition Report

640. There is some surface wear to the ruby in particular to the table facet edges. The cultured pearls are slightly dull. The diamonds are eight cut stones and look to be fairly clear. Overall the brooch would benefit from professional cleaning. Suggested age ♦ 1940s/50s. Weight 22.8g.

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
