A Victorian diamond brooch, designed as a single flower spray, mounted with a large rose cut diamond to the flowerhead centre, otherwise set with small rose cut diamonds and one cushion shaped diamond, width 2.5cm, fitted with a safety chain.

Condition Report

655. The principal diamond has several black pique inclusions, the other diamonds have a few pique inclusions. The diamonds otherwise slightly draw colour. One rose diamond has a significant fracture to the side. The folding hook to the clasp is a later replacement. Principal diamond weight approx 0.80-1.00ct. Colour: approx I. Clarity: approx I2. Weight 4.2g. Approx 1.1cm diameter. Central diamond is approx 6mm x 6mm.

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
