### LOT 755

A diamond pendant necklace, mounted with the principal cushion shaped diamond to the front drop, otherwise in a reconstructed pierced openwork design from a pair of earrings, on a faceted curb link neckchain with a diamond set cluster clasp, length 43cm, and a pair of diamond cluster earstuds, each mounted with a circular cut diamond within a surround of alternating circular and baguette cut diamonds, with post and butterfly fittings, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

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### Condition Report

755. The principal diamond slightly draws colour and has a few surface reaching inclusions near to one side edge, otherwise it is fairly clear. Principal diamond weight approx 1.00-1.50ct. Colour: approx L-M. Clarity: approx SI2. The remaining mostly eight cut diamonds slightly draw colour but look to be fairly clear stones. The diamond earstuds look to be attractive white stones and fairly clear. Overall good condition.

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
