A near pair of Howard scroll back armchairs, both upholstered in 'H & S' monogrammed ticking, one stamped 'Howard & Sons, Berners St. 19738 2478' to rear leg, the other bearing label detailed 'Lenygon & Morant Ltd Makers of Howard Chairs & Settees 48, South Audley St...' to underside of seat, both raised on square tapering legs terminating in brass castors, stamped 'Howard & Sons Ltd' height 84cm, width 76cm, depth 99cm.

Condition Report

2002. Frames and upholstery in generally good order with some minor wear and stains to the ticking and some minor scuffs and scratches to the legs. The springing seems ok and the padding is a bit soft but not bad. The castors are a little worn in their mounts and two caps are slightly loose. Otherwise good solid examples. Depths of seats 66cm.
