(Occasional spotting, closed area of loss to initial blank, ink annotation from 1557 on the initial blank, marginal damp-stain from Dd1 onwards.) 18th century black morocco, blind-tooled (rubbing to extremities, the words 'sans di trinitio' in ink on the fore-edge). Note: collates A-Y8, Aa-Ff8, colophon at Ff6.
