A Rolex Oyster Perpetual GMT-Master stainless steel and yellow gold cased gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, circa 1986, Ref. No. 16753, the signed jewelled movement numbered '1061712' and '3075', the signed black dial with luminous hour markers, Mercedes hands, date aperture and detailed 'Superlative Chronometer Officially Certified Swiss - T<25', the outer rotating black bezel with Arabic numerals, numbered between the lugs '16753' and '8940641', the tapered link jubilee bracelet numbered '450' with Rolex fold-over clasp, detailed 'Steelinox 62523H 18', case diameter 3.9cm, with Rolex guarantee, dated March 1986, original purchase receipt, wallet, booklets, box and related paperwork, including service history.

1100. The watch is in generally good clean condition with no significant damage or wear. Typical light surface scratches, but nothing of any real consequence. It adjusts smoothly and is currently in good working order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. One side has 8cm of strap and the other side has 7cm of strap, the three-fold adjustable clasp has a length of 3cm when closed. All services appear to have been carried out by Rolex with numerous Rolex receipts/invoices dating from 1992 through to 2010.
