LOT 1228

A William IV rosewood cased four glass table timepiece with brass single fusee movement, the backplate signed 'E Thompson 181, Sloane St. Knightsbridge No. 1272', the similarly signed silvered arch dial with black Roman numerals, the case with scroll mouldings and bevelled glass panels on a stepped plinth base with brass ball feet, height 29.5cm, with pendulum and winder. Note: Ebenezer Thompson was a watch and clockmaker, and is recorded working from Sloane Street, Knightsbridge, between 1830 and 1840.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

1228. Mechanism - single chain driven fusee mechanism that appears to be in working order with original pendulum.

Dial - in original condition with set of original blued steel spade hands.

Case - generally good condition but there is a repair to wood edge of one of the bevelled glass side panels beside the front door keyhole.

Original winding crank type key.
