1254. Mechanism in working order and passing strike working correctly. Hammer spring somewhat misshapen and requires attention. Correct size and period base and dome but not original to the clock, base recently repainted. Glass dome with very tiny nibbles to the lower edge. Chapter ring requires re-silvering and hour hand insecure. No maker's name.
