A late 19th century French ormolu and porcelain mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the white enamel dial with black Roman numerals and inscribed 'Simpson & Co à Paris', the case surmounted with three boys playing pétanque, the oval porcelain body painted en grisaille with cherubs in a woodland landscape on a blue ground, on an ormolu acanthus wreath base and toupie feet, height 37.5cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1240. Overall this clock appears to be in good condition. No damage to porcelain or enamel dial. Matched set of hands. Mechanism although clean is not working at the time of inspection. There is a very small stress fracture to base of ormolu group but it is to the rear and not really noticeable.

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
