An early 20th century tortoiseshell cased miniature timepiece, the enamel dial with Roman numerals and gilt detail, the rectangular case with hinged door, height 4.1cm, together with a burgundy leather mounted miniature clock case with dome top, pair of hinged doors and dial aperture, detailed 'Kendall & Co 12 Rue de la Paix-Paris' to base, height 6.5cm.

1268. The movement winds smoothly and is currently in good working order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Dial has a couple of faint hairlines. Tortoiseshell case in generally good order. Hinge is good. Few very minor chips to bottom edge and corners. Aperture is a little rough around the edge but this may have had a glass front and mount (?)
