### Condition Report

326. Leather case in generally good order with typical scuffs and wear.  
All silver mounts have typical surface scratches and wear.  
Large beaker - crack halfway up side starting at base, otherwise ok.  
Next size - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.  
Next size - crack through body almost the entire length.  
Next size - Horn in good condition, silver rim more mishapen than others and split.  
Next size - Good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.  
Smallest size - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
