A set of four George III silver candlesticks, each with a detachable nozzle above a baluster stem and circular base, with gadrooned bands, Sheffield 1809 by John Watson, height 29cm.

Condition Report

340. The set are in generally fairly good honest condition but are a little tired with some dents and knocks. Two of the wooden base inserts are a bit warped so sticks don't stand perfectly flat. One has a small split to the knob and another stem tiolts a little to one side. Typical surface scratches, wear and minor dents commensuate with age of 'loaded' candlesticks. No apparent repairs. Good clear hallmarks only slightly rubbed.
